Middle School Teachers will be available on a "drop-in" basis for P.T. Conferences

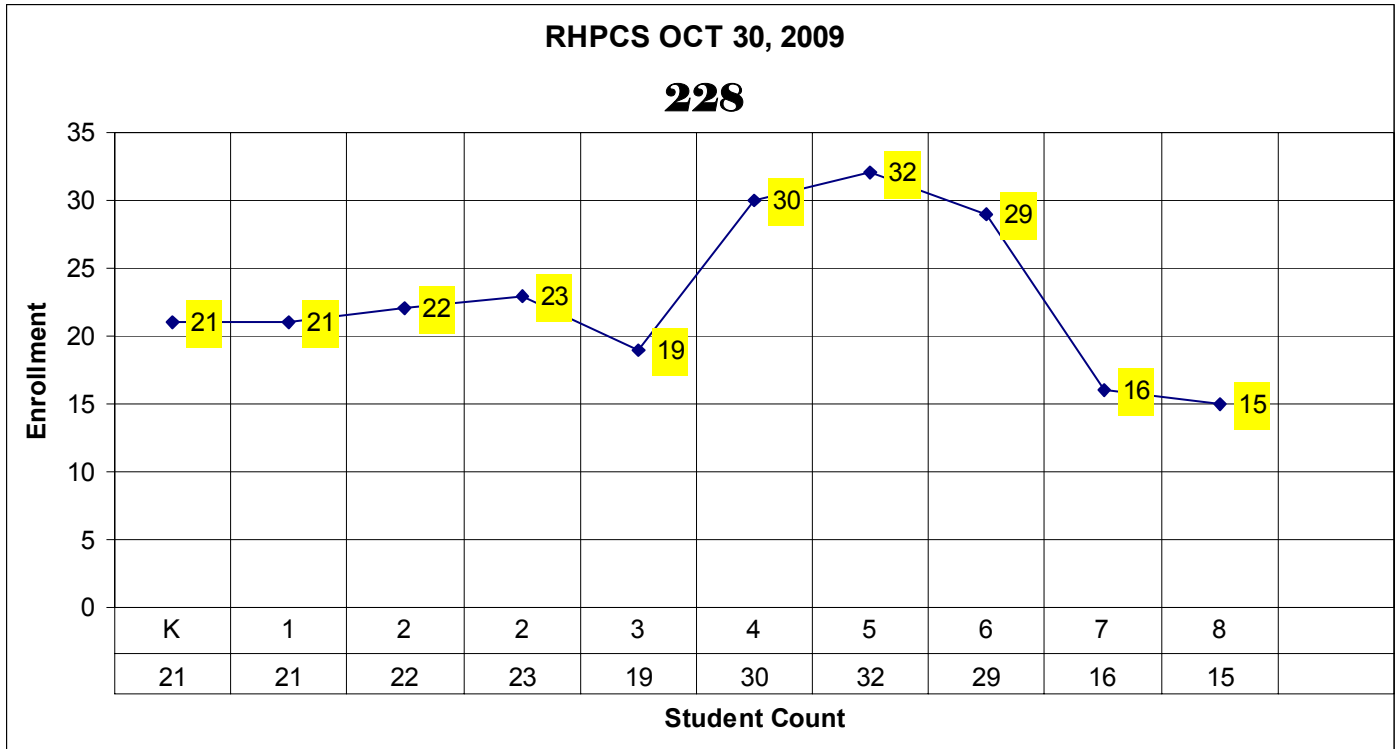
