### Illness and Absence from School

If your child is out of school for the day and is home sick please remember to call the office.

We have had a couple of cases of pink eye and strep throat at the school. Please note the following from the Central District Health Department:

#### *Pink Eye*

*Symptoms include itching, irritation, and a scratchy feeling in the eye, and a discharge which may cause the eyelids to stick together in the am.*

#### *Strep Throat*

*Symptoms include sudden onset of red sore throat, fever, listlessness, swollen glands, nausea, and headache.*

*If you believe your child has these symptoms, please refer to your health care provider for diagnosis and treatment.*

As part of our commitment to health care, we are encouraging children to wash hands repeatedly and we are wiping down door handles and counters daily.
