Rolling Hills Guidelines for Gym Shoes

In order to protect our new gym floor and for the health and safety of our students, please note the guidelines below for proper footwear.

1. Clean, lace tied or Velcro fastened gym shoes ONLY. No zipper, slip-on or any other fasteners will be allowed. No platform, elevated soles, roller tennis shoes or hiking-style tennis shoes will be allowed.
2. Shoes must cover the whole feet. Shoes missing any parts (heels, toes, etc.) will not be allowed.
3. Bottoms of shoes must be white or non-marking black. Any shoes that mark the floor will not be allowed.
