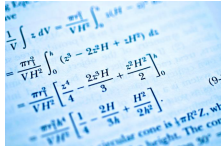

2010 Rolling Hills Math Challenge!

What is a BoxTop you ask? A BoxTop is a small logo/certificate (usually tiny) that looks similar to the logo in this section of the newsletter. The logo can be found on a wide-range of grocery items like cereal boxes, cake mix, refrigerated cookie dough, Ziplock baggies and many more. The certificates need to be torn or cut off the package in one piece and the expiration date must be in the future. Each certificate is worth ten cents for our school.
