

**RHPCS 2011-2012**  
**School Supply List – Grades 6-8**

- Backpack – (1) full size backpack (Backpack should not be larger than 16" x 12" x 7" and should be able to fit comfortably into student's locker where it will remain throughout the day. A separate small handbag may be carried from class to class if desired.)
- Student Planner/Daytimer – (1) daily planner of your choice to be used to track daily homework, assignments, project timelines and due dates for multiple subjects/classes
- Pencil/supply bag – (1) small zippered bag to hold writing instruments/supplies inside binder
- Pencils – (36 at least) #2 pencils (sharpened) – mechanical pencils can be used if desired
- Erasers – (2) large pink erasers
- Erasers – (2) package pencil top erasers
- Pens – (4) ink pens for correcting work, any color (not felt tip or markers, please!)
- Writing Instrument – (1) cool writing instrument of your choice (for Author's Workshop)
- Highlighter – (4) highlighting pens
- Dry Erase – (16) Expo dry erase markers (broad/chisel tip)
- Dry Erase – (2) dry erase erasers or (2) old socks to use as eraser
- Colored Pencils – (1) package colored pencils
- Glue Sticks – (2) glue sticks
- Folders – (3) 2-pocket folders with 3-hole punches to allow them to be put inside a binder
- Binder – (1) 1" 3-ring binder filled with lined paper labeled for Social Studies
- Binder – (1) 1" 3-ring binder filled with lined paper labeled for Math
- Binder – (1) 1" 3-ring binder filled with lined paper and dividers labeled Language Arts, Spelling, Vocabulary, and Writing
- Notebook – (1) Author's notebook (a fun 3-hole punched notebook sized so that if you tear out the paper it will fit in your binder)
- Paper – (3) packages loose leaf lined paper (still in package –this paper is in addition to the paper used to fill your binders)
- Post-it notes – (2) packages regular-sized Post-It notes
- World Atlas - (1) – (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade only)
- \*Candy – (1) bag individually wrapped hard candy, any kind
- \*Trail Mix – (1) bag trail mix, any kind
- \*Kleenex- (3) boxes
- \*Hand Sanitizer – (1) bottle
- \*Disinfecting wipes- (3) containers
- \*Napkins – (1) package of 100
- \*Paper Plates/Plasticware – item to be provided determined by the first letter of your child's last name:  
(A-L) – 300 paper plates (can be the inexpensive variety, but paper only please – not Styrofoam)  
(M-Z) (100) plastic forks and (100) plastic spoons

*\*All supplies marked with the star will be community items and will not need names on them*

OPTIONAL Extras for the classroom: These items are NOT required, but if you are able to donate them to the classroom, we WILL use them if we have them. Thanks!

**Additional supplies required for Spanish instruction:**

Binder – (1) 1" binder (any kind) with (10) page protectors, 3 to 5 tab dividers, and lined paper inside  
Spanish/English Dictionary – (1) (required for grades 3-8 only)
