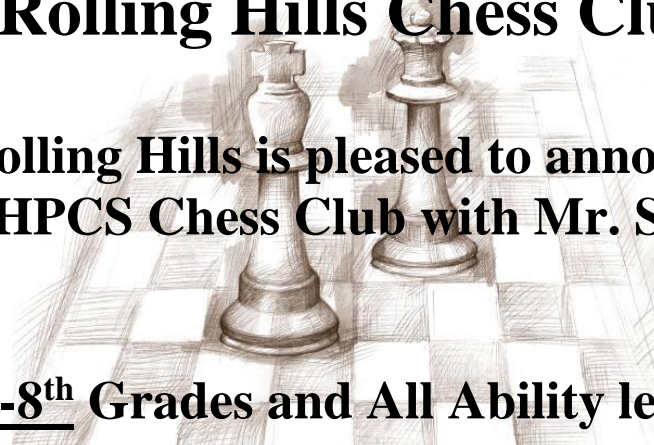




Rolling Hills Chess Club
