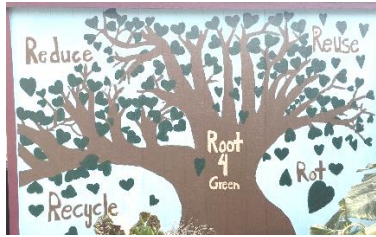




Rolling Hills Root 4 Green Garden Club
